

National Assessment of Educational Progress Scores (2015) and Graduation Rates (2015-2016)





New Hampshire State Budget Inflation-Adjusted Dollars





New Hampshire Statewide Enrollments in Public Schools





New Hampshire Food Stamp Program Recipients


Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Recipients in the State



New Hampshire Health Protection Program Enrollment and Expenditures


Number of Cases and Service Expenditures by Month
