### Poverty Rates

With a 2019 poverty rate of 7.3 percent, approximately 100,000 Granite Staters in New Hampshire lived in poverty. Approximately 250,000 people had incomes below twice the poverty threshold.

#### Residents in Poverty

People living at less than twice the federal poverty threshold (FPT)

<200% FPT: 1 in 5 ..... 248,000

People in or near poverty

<150% FPT: 1 in 8 ..... 164,000

People in poverty

<100% FPT: 1 in 13 ..... 96,000

People in deep poverty

<50% FPL: 1 in 27 ..... 41,000

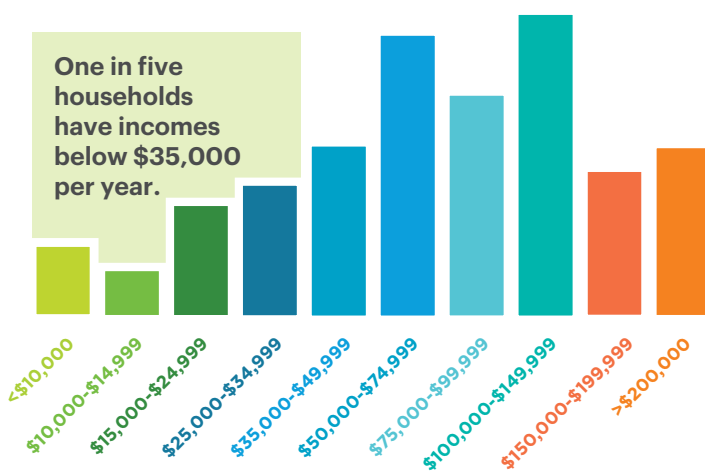

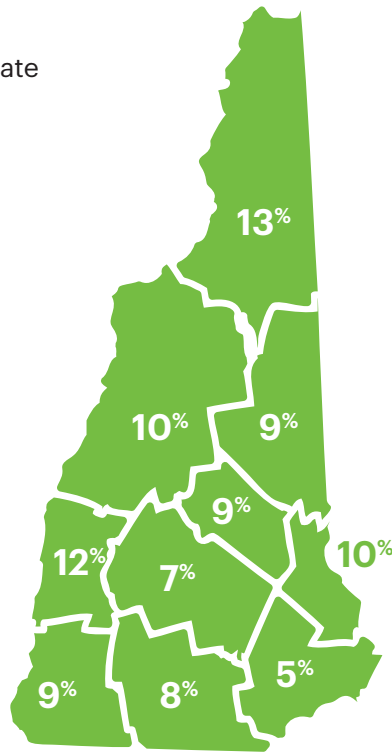

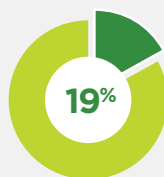
