The New Hampshire Fiscal Policy Institute (NHFPI) will host its 9th Annual Budget and Policy Conference at the Grappone Conference Center in Concord on Friday, December 6, 2024.

Last year, NHFPI had over 300 registrants, a record number that included policymakers, community leaders, journalists, and interested residents. The speakers and discussions highlighted ways New Hampshire can strengthen Granite Staters' economic security, helping address workforce constraints employers face by examining the challenges and lifting up policy solutions.

The 2025 Legislative Session will see the creation of a new two-year State Budget, which will be an opportunity to make investments in New Hampshire individuals and families as well as address our state's most pressing challenges. This conference will provide attendees with an understanding of what comprises the State Budget, how New Hampshire funds the State Budget, and how topics such as child care, housing, income and economic security, health, public education, tax and revenue policy, and population demographics are all interconnected.

As the <u>New Hampshire Bulletin</u> notes, "lawmakers have long looked to [NHFPI] for nonpartisan financial analysis." To this effect, NHFPI is able to leverage its unique position in New Hampshire's public policy ecosystem as a trusted, independent source of information to bring key stakeholders together to discuss policy considerations and solutions for the Granite State.

Registration will open in October. We are currently working to secure event sponsorship, which will significantly underwrite costs (and provide free registration for state policymakers) so that we can help ensure equitable access for all.
