

## ALL COUNTY POPULATIONS HAVE GROWN SINCE 2010 EXCEPT COOS











Number of People by Age Group as of July 1, 2023






## PERCENTAGE OF POPULATION OVER AGE 65 EXPECTED TO GROW

Projections by Age Group, for 2020 to 2050



Estimates of Domestic and International Migration by Age Group, from 2018 to 2022\*







### NUMBER OF JOB OPENINGS PER NEW HAMPSHIRE RESIDENT ACTIVELY SEEKING WORK



2023 Data, Labor Force Participants Age 16 or Over Unless Otherwise Labeled, Rounded to Nearest 1,000






### WHY ARE PEOPLE STAYING OUT OF THE LABOR FORCE?
















New Hampshire Statewide Data, Two Bedroom Apartments


